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Academic Success

- Student achieve their target grades - set aspirationally using ALPS our students meet their target grades.
- 25% of students are receiving A*- A as an average over the last 3 years - this has enabled high numbers to access Oxbridge and Russell Group Universities.
- Nationally and locally our results in English, Maths, Geography, History and Computer Science are excellent - Top 25% of schools Nationally.
- 30 Linear A Level subjects, 9 Vocational courses and 14 enrichment options.

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Destination Success

- All our students go on to a professional destination.
- Applications this year for Oxbridge are high.
- Students go on to study academic University courses such as Physics with Astronomy at Southampton University, Mathematics at Exeter University, Microbiology at Imperial, Aeronautics and Astronautics at Southampton University, Sports Technology at Loughborough, Theatre Sound at The Royal Central School for Speech and Drama, Law at York University and Digital Games Development at Brighton University.

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What are the entry requirements?

Minimum Sixth Form Entry Criteria

- 5 or more GCSE or equivalent grades at 4 to 9.

Minimum Subject Entry Criteria

- Each subject has an individual entry criteria, use the options booklet to ensure that you meet any additional requirements in order to study your preferred subjects.
- Some subjects may have a 'Route A' and 'Route B' entry option.

Minimum Subject Entry Options

- A minimum of 3 and maximum of 4 subjects can be selected plus 1 compulsory enrichment option.
- *Please Note:*
 - *A course may not be offered if there are too few students wishing to study that subject.*
 - *We cannot guarantee that all student subject combinations can be offered.*

 - What are your future plans and desired destinations?
 - What does the 'Need to Achieve' mean to you?
- Deadline - 31st January 2020
 - *Applications can be made throughout the year but we encourage students to meet this deadline.*
- **Interviews** with a member of SLT or the Sixth Form Team
 1. Conditional offer made, or
 2. A second interview followed by a possible conditional offer made, or
 3. Referral to the Careers Team

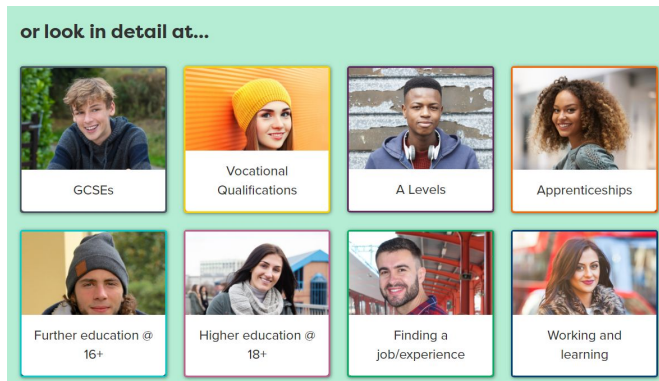

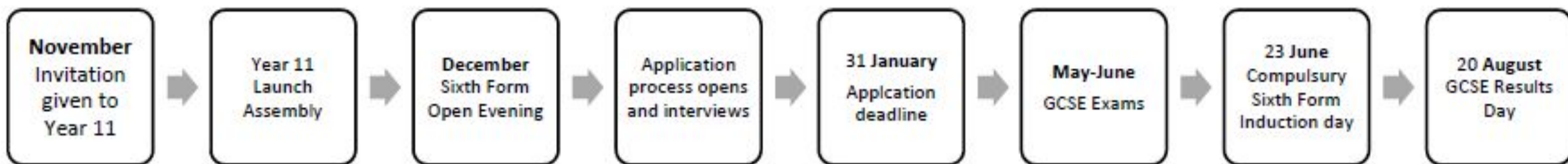
- Start your **research and planning early**

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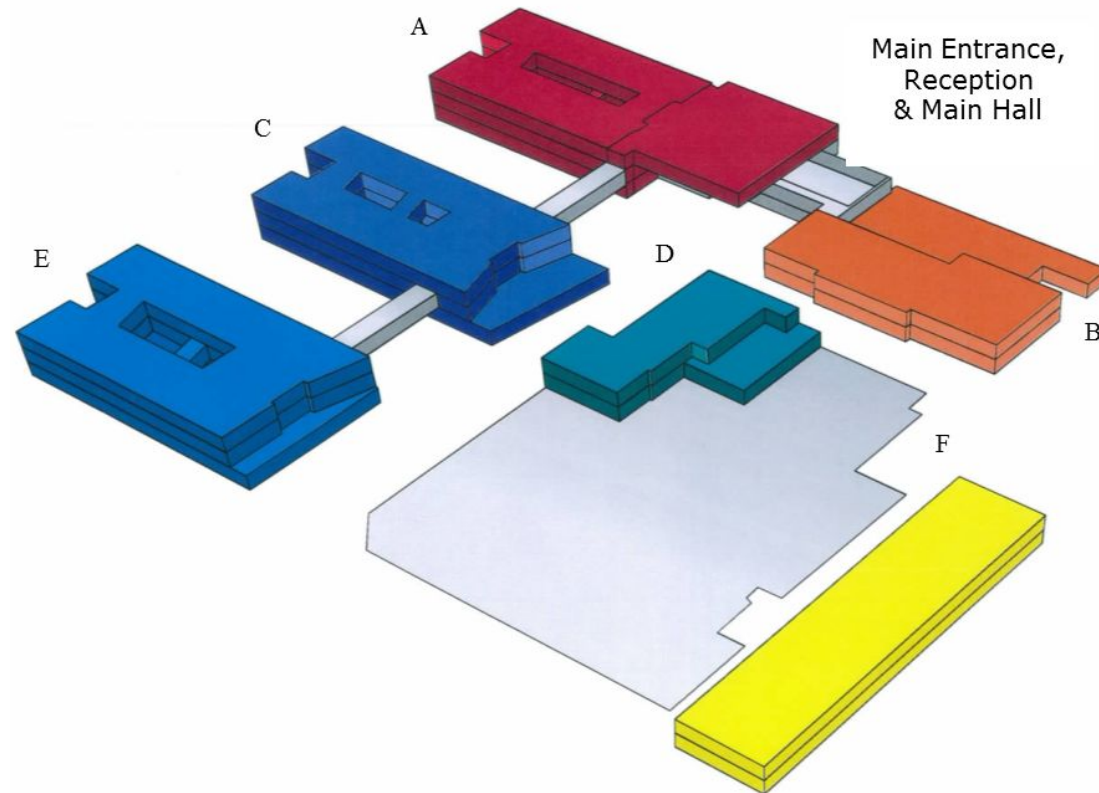
